I've been working professionally in the web industry since 2005. Most of my earliest work involved creating animations and rich interactive web apps (using Flash) for the marketing sector. During that time I collaborated with and worked for brands such as Macy's, The Food Network, Mattel, and Hallmark.

In 2010, I formally switched from Flash to PHP, focusing on building custom websites for clients using platforms like WordPress, Drupal, and Magento. Around 2012, I started to learn frameworks Django and Ruby on Rails and gained experience working at startup and large Ad agencies such as Osborn and Barr. I mostly worked as a freelance contractor during this time.

Later in 2014 I went in house and worked as Server-Side Ruby developer for a SaaS mobile app company called CVent.

In 2018, I left to go work for the largest local nonprofit in Oregon using Elixir with Phoenix.

As of today, my main focus has been in Elixir, JS, and I've started to learn Rust.

Aside from development, I also enjoy Server admin work Such as SRE and automating integration and deployments. Recently, I've also developed a renewed interest in Javascript due to advancements in EcmaScript standards, and I believe both Javascript and Elixir are rapidly evolving and shaping the current web landscape with new frameworks such as LiveView and Wasm browser support.

Naturally I would like to find opportunities to keep working with Elixir, Javascript and Rust moving into the future. Hopefully that's why you are reading this.
